**Batley Sports and Tennis Centre, Windmill Lane, Batley, West Yorkshire, WF17 0QD (tel: 01924 326181).**

- Exit M62 Motorway at junction 27.
- *If exiting Westbound, travel all the way around the roundabout and back on yourself up to the large roundabout. At this roundabout, take the third exit onto the A650 towards Morley.*
- *If exiting Eastbound, take the third exit onto the A650 towards Morley.*
- Follow the A650 in the direction of Morley for half a mile, through first lights, turning right at the second set of traffic lights (main junction) into Howden Clough Road.
- Follow this road for approximately one and a half miles and look out for the sign for the Sports Centre up to the left and turn left up Upper Batley Lane.
- After a few hundred metres there will be another sign for the Sports Centre to the left. This takes you up Windmill Lane.
- The Sports Centre is on the right after the School entrance.
